



GUTHRIE THEATER

Directions and Parking



ADDRESS

818 South 2nd Street, Minneapolis, MN 55415

Located in downtown Minneapolis along the Mississippi River, you'll find the Guthrie Theater between Mill City Museum and Gold Medal Park.

BY CAR

From the North (I-35W)

Heading south on I-35W, take the Washington Avenue exit (17C). Turn RIGHT onto Washington Avenue. Turn RIGHT onto 11th Avenue South. Turn LEFT onto South 2nd Street and go 2 blocks. The Guthrie will be on your right.

From the North (I-94)

Heading east on I-94, take the North 4th Street exit (230). Turn LEFT onto 3rd Avenue South. Turn RIGHT onto South 2nd Street and go 4 blocks. The Guthrie will be on your left.

From the West (I-394)

Heading east on I-394, take the 3rd Avenue North/Washington Avenue exit (9C). Take the Washington Avenue ramp. Turn RIGHT onto Washington Avenue. Turn LEFT onto Chicago Avenue. Turn RIGHT onto South 2nd Street. The Guthrie will be on your left.

From the South (I-35W)

Heading north on I-35W, take the 3rd Avenue/Washington Avenue exit (17C). Turn LEFT onto Washington Avenue. Turn RIGHT onto 11th Avenue South. Turn LEFT onto South 2nd Street and go 2 blocks. The Guthrie will be on your right.

From the East (I-94)

Heading west on I-94, take the 7th Street exit (234B). Turn RIGHT onto 11th Avenue South. Turn LEFT onto South 2nd Street and go 2 blocks. The Guthrie will be on your right.

BY LIGHT RAIL

Take the Blue Line (from South Minneapolis/MOA/MSP Airport) or Green Line (from University of Minnesota/St. Paul) to U.S. BANK STADIUM STATION and walk north (toward the Mississippi River) on Chicago Avenue until you reach South 2nd Street. The Guthrie will be across the street.

BY BUS

There are several Metro Transit bus routes with stops near the Guthrie. To find the best route, go to www.metrotransit.org and plan your trip. Transportation may also be scheduled through Metro Mobility.

CAR PARKING

Riverfront Ramp

Parking is available in the city-owned Riverfront Ramp across from the Guthrie on South 2nd Street. The rate for Guthrie events is typically \$10 but may vary based on other events in the area. **NOTE:** You may pay by credit card at the exit or at one of several pay stations inside the ramp.

Clearance is 8 feet, 2 inches at the entrance and 7 feet in the rest of the ramp. Limited van parking is available near the ramp entrance.

Mill Quarter Ramp

Parking is also available at the Mill Quarter Ramp on South 2nd Street just west of Chicago Avenue. Rates vary. Clearance is 8 feet, 2 inches throughout the ramp.

BUS DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Use the bus dropoff and pickup zone directly in front of the Guthrie's main entrance on the north side of South 2nd Street (look for the red-capped meters and signs). DO NOT BLOCK the pedestrian crosswalk or service entrance. Double parking is not permitted on South 2nd Street at any time. To avoid show traffic, buses may also drop off and pick up at the Guthrie's back entrance along West River Parkway (this entrance has stairs). **NOTE:** No parking or idling is allowed in the bus dropoff and pickup zones.



BUS PARKING

The Guthrie does not provide bus parking and options in the area are limited. Bus drivers are welcome to make their own parking arrangements, but be advised that buses may be ticketed for parking violations.

- Buses may park at city parking meters near the Guthrie provided they pay the meters and obey posted time and date restrictions. Idling is not allowed at any meter.
- Groups may contract directly with a private parking lot to arrange prepaid bus parking. ABM and Impark own parking lots near the Guthrie.
- Groups may contact the City of Minneapolis and pay for hooded meters designated for your buses. In addition to the hooding and lost revenue fees, you will be required to obtain a free obstruction permit from the city.

ARRIVAL TIME

We recommend arriving 20-30 minutes before the show begins to allow enough time for your group to take their seats. Performances are not delayed for late arrivals. If your group is late, you may be asked to wait in the lobby until a break in the action and enter the theater at the discretion of Guthrie staff.
