## Signing Up for Camps

### How do I determine the grade level for my camper?

The grade ranges listed for each summer camp indicate the grade your camper needs to be enrolled in as of fall 2026. For example, if your camper is currently in 7th grade and will be going into 8th grade in fall 2026, they are eligible to attend any camps for grades 6-8 or grades 8-12. They would not be eligible to attend any camps for grades 9-12.

### The camp I am interested in is sold out. What do I do?

Please register to be on our waitlist. We sometimes have cancellations, and we will alert you if space becomes available.

## Location and Directions

### Where do the camps take place?

All camps are held at the Guthrie Theater, primarily in the classrooms on Level Eight and the rehearsal rooms on Level One.

### Where is the Guthrie Theater located?

The Guthrie Theater is located at 818 South 2nd Street in downtown Minneapolis.

### May I get to the Guthrie from the light rail or by public transportation?

## First Day of Camp Check-In

### What time does check-in begin?

Check-in begins at 8:45 a.m. on Level One.

### What should my camper bring?

Bring your completed forms (if not emailed), a reusable water bottle, a healthy bag lunch and snacks (optional). If they bring a backpack, we can store it in a cubby. We ask campers not to have their phones in the classrooms, so it is better to leave them at home.

### What should my camper wear?

Campers will receive a summer camp T-shirt when they check in. We ask that campers wear their T-shirt on the first and last days of camp. On other days, campers should wear comfortable clothing they can move in and rubbersoled, closed-toe and closed-back shoes like tennis shoes. No flip-flops or clogs, please.

## Dropoff and Pickup

### When can I drop off and pick up my camper?

Please drop off campers no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and pick them up no later than 4:15 p.m.

### Where should I drop off and pick up my camper?

At the main entrance on South 2nd Street. A Guthrie staff member will be there to greet campers as they arrive.

### May my camper leave without an adult?

Campers ages 13 and up are free to leave the Guthrie after camp without adult supervision if you submitted a Child Release Waiver during registration.

### What if my camper needs to leave early or arrive late?

Contact the Education Team in advance (see the Summer Camp Guide for contact information). Only caregivers may authorize early dismissals.

### What if I'm late for pickup?

Contact the Education Team immediately.

## Parking

### Where can I park?

There are a few options available:

- Street parking (two-hour meters) on South 2nd Street
- The city-owned Riverfront Ramp across from the Guthrie (rates may vary during events)
- Additional neighborhood lots

## Reaching Your Camper During Camp

### How do I reach my camper during the day?

### May my camper bring a phone?

Yes, but it must be turned off and stored in their backpack during camp instruction. Phones may be checked at lunch.

## Clothing

### What should my camper wear?

Campers will receive a summer camp T-shirt when they check in. We ask that campers wear their T-shirt on the first and last days of camp. On other days, campers should wear comfortable clothing they can move in and rubber-soled, closed-toe and closed-back shoes like tennis shoes. No flip-flops or clogs, please.

## Food and Drink

### **Is lunch provided?**

No. Please provide a healthy bag lunch (including a beverage) and snacks (optional). There will not be access to a refrigerator or microwave.

### **Are water fountains available?**

Yes. Campers are encouraged to bring a reusable water bottle.

## Final Sharing

### **Is there a performance at the end of camp?**

Yes. Each camp ends with a final sharing on the last day from 3 to 4 p.m.

### **Will I get details about the final sharing?**

Yes. You'll receive an email with more information midway through the camp.
