Health and Safety: Masks



About the COVID-19 Virus

The Guthrie wants to keep all guests, audiences, artists and staff as safe as possible while COVID-19 continues to affect our community. The COVID-19 virus is spread from person to person through germs, which are found in the tiny droplets of fluid that come from a person's mouth when they cough, sneeze, breathe and talk.



Mask Recommendation

If I am here to see a show, I can choose to wear a face mask that completely covers my mouth and nose the entire time I am inside the theater. This mask will help prevent the spread of germs by blocking the fluid droplets from my nose and mouth from entering the air around me.

Masks are recommended but not required inside the theater during relaxed performances.



Types of Masks

I can wear a washable cloth mask or a disposable surgical face mask while I am inside the theater. My mask should cover my nose and mouth at all times.

I should bring my own mask to wear. The Guthrie may have cloth masks available for purchase in the Store. There may be disposable masks available at one of the Guest Services Desks on Levels One, Four or Five. There is no guarantee that masks will be available in the Store or at the desks.
