## Photo and Video Policy

**The Guthrie is open to the public and guests are welcome to take photos and record video in the lobbies for personal, non-commercial use.**

### **Inside the theaters**

While photography of actors onstage is not allowed at any time, photography of the set only is allowed preshow, postshow and during intermission. We encourage you to credit the designers listed on the Creative Team page of the program and to tag Guthrie Theater (@GuthrieTheater) in your social media posts.

Video or audio capture of any performance is strictly prohibited. Guthrie Visitor Services reserves the right to request disruptive patrons leave the performance at any time.

### **Portrait and wedding photography**

Portrait and wedding photographers are welcome to use the lobbies of Levels Four, Five and Nine free of charge with the following restrictions:

- Photography must not interfere with Guthrie events or pre-show activity in the lobbies. For the convenience and safety of our patrons, photography of any group must cease one hour before show time; our performance schedule is available at [guthrietheater.org](http://guthrietheater.org).
- Photographers must be self-contained, with no additional or free-standing equipment (i.e. no tripods, lights, electrical cords, etc.)
- Moving furniture and climbing in or on the window boxes is strictly prohibited.

### **Professional or commercial photography**

To inquire about a professional or commercial shoot at the Guthrie Theater or in Sea Change, including architectural and fashion photography, filmmakers and production companies, e-mail [press@guthrietheater.org](mailto:press@guthrietheater.org). Please note: All professional or commercial shoots generally require 30-day notice.
